Over the past month there has been a rise of ONLINE incidents which involve teenagers using SOCIAL MEDIA.

The issues stem from youths sending abusive messages (which can not be repeated here) to a victim on social media channels such as SNAP CHAT, WHATSAPP and TIK TOK

The Victim tries to ignore / block the person , but however they are added to group chats or even fake accounts are made up.


As adults, when we were at school , issues that occurred within school were left at school , however now youths bring their issues home as they can not escape as they have their Mobile phones with them and use social media , the issues continue and this affects their mental health. They can not escape.

DID YOU KNOW -

If there was a group chat of approx 20 people and abusive messages were sent from one person to a victim. And that victim does something , everyone in that group would be in trouble.

WHY WOULD EVERYONE BE IN TROUBLE ?

The reason why all 19 other people would be in trouble for one person sending abusive messages , is the fact that No one challenged it , no one notified



We have been notified that there are year group chats within High Schools, and when we attend PRIMARY SCHOOLS and hear that there is class chats , concerns are raised , which then involves ONLINE SAFETY talks from PCSO's. So there are major concerns to hear that HIGH SCHOOLS have year group chats.

We do advise to **ALL PARENTS** to keep their loved ones safe when it comes to online social media usage, which includes :



- start conversations which involve social media usage , find out what your loved one does online
- Encourage them NOT to join group chats , unless they are in chats with trusted friends
- Understand what apps your loved one is using , as most SOCIAL MEDIA apps (TIK TOK / SNAP CHAT) have a age restriction of 13.
- Use apps such as GOOGLE FAMILY LINK to monitor and protect your loved ones

Nothing is ever deleted of a phone , every message / image is stored and can be obtained if there is any ever issue which involves social media / phones. We do never want to confiscate any youths mobile phone , due to social media use. But if there is an incident in which involves social media then phones will be confiscated.

We are also hearing that more and more younger children are being allowed to use these SOCIAL MEDIA APPS , it is important as a parent that you do keep your loved ones safe.

So please keep your loved ones safe when it comes to ONLINE USAGE.

IF SOMEONE ASKES YOU TO INSTALL ANYDESK— STOP !!!

The issues of FRAUD is still affecting our residents and the major issues involves TRUST being formed the Victim and SCAMMER and then being asked to install ANYDESK.

***** ANYDESK *****

This is an app that gives the person who is calling you , TOTAL CONTROL on the device they are using. And will have access to all information that is stored on the device. So they will let you see what they want to see , whilst behind the scenes they are scamming you.

Below are the issues that the community policing team are dealing with ...

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Two people possibly smoking cannabis whilst walking past reporting persons address –**RESPONSE officers dispatched—searsh made no trace. As this is a public area PCSO ROBERTSON wont be conducting reassurance unless a regular issue.**
- Reporting person witnessed a fight between teenage boys on their way towards to LOCKS, partner broke the fight up and everyone went their own way. Does have camera footage if required—**No further action , unless there is a report from the victim. However PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Black Range Rover parking on the footpath and is causing a complete obstruction .—**RESPONSE OFFICERS** were passing the area and checked the area, there was no signs of the vehicle

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Concern over an address as there is Christmas lights still up and the curtains have not been opened—**passed to RIGHT CARE RIGHT PERSON**
- Reporting persons son has been pulled off bike and attacked by another male—**PCSO ROBERTSON has been made aware of this and advised the caller to report it in , so its officially logged. PCSO ROBERTSON is attending the address. CCTV will be checked as he access to it.**
- Concern in regards to a Male chopping trees down and digging holes in an area which may be COUNCIL LAND—**anon reporter therefore PCSO ROBERTSON can not do a reassurance visit , but will patrol area in which is stated in report**
- Reporting person was trying to help a neighbour which suddenly turned into threats being received—**PCSO ROBERTSON will attend address and speak to reporting person as this may be linked to a previous issue**
- Suspicious male walking into close and looking into neighbours car window—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit**
- 2 youths see gaining entry to the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY building—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and youths located and searched. PCSO ROBERTSON will contact the council in regarding to ensure area is made secure.**
- Male was seen taking a picture of a Newspaper with reporting persons house in the background—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and CCTV footage has been recovered showing the male. House to house has been completed in surrounding area. OFFICERS investigating this. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit..**
- Neighbour being intimidated and shouted at over a parking space -**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**
- Youths possibly gaining access to LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched—area searched no trace , however school was finishing for the day so patrols stayed in place. CWAC have been notified of the issue and we have been advised that area will be made secure**
- Concern over a male who is not moving. Reporting person can see them through the window—**AMUBLUANCE issue which has attended , police stood down**
- Reporting person has received threatening voicemails in regards to money—**SAFEGAURDING ADVICE given -PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**
- 3 x reports in regards to a group of people fighting—**RESPONSE officers dispatched**

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

- Neighbour cutting down trees that are on communal land—**This is a civil issue and should be took up with Council , as POLICE don't deal with land right issues**
- 2nd report in regards to further damage to trees by neighbour—**PCSO ROBERTSON will speak to reporting person to offer advice as its dealing with land , its either a civil / council issues**

- Dog got loose from an address and grabbed POST OFFICE delivery persons coat—**RESPONSE** officer attended the address and spoke to owner of the Dog. There is damage to the fence due to the bad weather. As there was no injuries, advice was given.

- Copper stolen from a Van whilst working on telegraph poles —**Crimed**

BURGULARY

- Theres movement in an address and there is a flashlight being used —**False alarm everyone is safe and well**
- Male kicking at the front door and trying to gain entry—**RESPONSE OFFICERS** dispatched—search of area conducted, no trace of male.

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Male running away from an address and getting into a van, and then driving away at speed— **this has been logged as INTEL as no other reports. No address details of where the male came from. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit**
- Reporting person's son ran off whilst having a melt down and there was concerns about his welfare , whilst on call , son was located—**As son was located there was no need to dispatch, however PCSO ROBERTSON will still conduct reassurance visit.**
- Female having a PANIC ATTACK , range 101 by mistake , was advised to call 999 for ambulance—**AMBULANCE was called for.**

SHOPLIFTING

- Repeat offender attending TESCO and shoplifting , has attended 3 times over the past week —**crimed and CCTV footage will be collected by PCSO ROBERTSON**

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Concern over a child due to some excessing shouting within a premises—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and spoke to the mother. The shouting was due to an agreement over the phone. Child safe and well and there are no concerns PC BOX and PCSO ROBERTSON are aware**
- Neighbour has attended reporting persons address shouting and being very aggressive and started to make false allegations against them—**ONGOING ISSUE in which PCSO ROBERTSON will attend and speak to all parties as there is an ongoing neighbour issue**
- Male urinating near reporting persons home—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit**
- Neighbour causing issues for reporting person by shouting abuse—**This is the 3rd report this month , PCSO ROBERTSON is working with partner agencies in regards to this. PCSO ROBERTSON will advise reporting person in regards to this.**
- Suspicious male sat outside reporting persons house for past 30minutes—**RESPONSE officers dispatched , upon arrival vehicle was empty , safeguarding advice given.**
- Further issues with neighbour shouting abuse
- Second report in the day in regards to neighbour , this time threats were stated —**PCSO ROBERTSON is working with our partner agencies in response to this. PCSO ROBERTSON and PC BOX will attend and speak with the neighbour. RESPONSE OFFICERS have attended and spoken to all parties**

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

- Female has driven into a pump at SPAR , damaged it and fuel has leaked over forecourt—**CRIMED , PCSO ROBERTSON will attend to view and collect CCTV.**

THEFT

- Money has been taken from a machine due to it being damaged—**CRIMED , CCTV is being checked**

BOSTOCK

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Broken down vehicle near the roundabout in the middle lane - **RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and vehicle could not be located. So vehicle was recovered**



MOULTON

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Female attending reporting persons address to threaten reporting persons son—**FEMALE** spoken to and given a **COMMUNITY RESOLUTION**. PCSO **ROBERTSON** will attend address for reassurance
- Male is **INTOXICATED** outside reporting persons house—**AMBULANCE** have been called but **RESPONSE OFFICERS** attended and took male home, so all safe and well.
- Concern over a neighbour was unsteady on her feet the night before and then this morning there was no answer—**Reporting person** advised to contact ambulance.

FRAUD

- Person losing a significant amount of money due to investment in regards to a fake **MARTIN LEWIS** commercial

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

- Two bricks thrown at reporting persons window —**Officers and CSI** have looked into this and there are no lines of enquiry as no **CCTV**. PCSO **ROBERTSON** will conduct a reassurance visit.




You have requested speed gun sessions on certain roads via the residents voice.

Only 2 Speed Gun sessions were conducted in February


WEAVER HALL –London Road which is 30MPH , just outside the Museum. There was 0 offences



DAVENHAM –HARTFORD ROAD which is 20MPH , the speed gun session was completed on the school run, due to the amount of people heading to school. Wanted to see if the roads are safe for those who are walking

There was a total of 4 offences captured with the highest speed being 28 MPH

More areas will be looked into as well as if there is an area with offences captured , the more speed gun sessions will take place there.





KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE— PARENTS ASKED TO PARK CORRECTLY

Over the past two years with our previous MINI POLICE teams they have tackled parking , which has improved around the school. However there have been a few issues ,reports from residents and tickets issued by PCSO ROBERTSON. So with that the Mini Police decided that parking was the first thing for them to tackle.

With this the Mini Police were assigned to get a certain number of parents signed up to the brand new MINI POLICE PARKING PROMISE. The Mini Police split into two teams , one team asked parents as they arrived at school “Have you drive to school today?” And if they answered YES they would be escorted over to a table where the other half of the MINI POLICE would be, to which they would ask “Will you promise to park correctly going forward” And asked to sign the Parking Promise.

The Mini Police were assigned to get 50 parents signed up. Over the course of pick up / end of school time , the Mini Police had managed to get 68 parents signed up.


Now in March the Mini Police will see if the parents keep to their Promise as they will be conducting parking patrols.

In the past month in the DAVENHAM AND MOULTON area , we have sworn in two new teams , as the DAVENHAM MINI POLICE and LEFTWICH MINI POLICE were sworn in.



At the beginning of the month , the DAVENHAM MINI POLICE were sworn in which was attended by MRS HYSLOP, MRS NIXON and POLICE OFFICERS.

The outgoing Davenham Mini Police attended and graduated as they passed the torch over to the new Mini Police team.

Then at the end of the month we introduced the brand new LEFTWICH MINI POLICE team, which was attended by MRS GUY and the NORTHWICH SOUTH SERGEANT (SGT JONES).

Both ceremonies were hosted by PCSO ROBERTSON who will work with both teams alongside the Kingsmead Mini Police.

Over the course of the next Month the Davenham Mini Police will start their patrols with a Mini Police Court and the Leftwich Mini Police will start looking at parking with their Mini Police Parking Promise.

The Davenham and Moulton Area is the first area within Northwich to have 3 teams of Mini Police.
