Below are the issues that the community policing team are dealing with ...

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Reporting person can hear a door being kicked in—**RESPONSE OFFICERS** attended and male **ARRESTED**
- Group of youths being suspicious around a bike that has been chained up , which have been scared away by Neighbours— **RESPONSE OFFICERS** dispatched—search made no trace of any youths in area. **PCSO ROBERTSON** spoke to reported person in regards to this—no further issues
- Reporting persons child is getting bullied and there are fake accounts being made up and school are aware— **PCSO ROBERTSON** will speak to reporting person in regards to issues that they have mentioned. Working with **PC WARD** (youth engagement officer in regards to this)

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Vehicles parking too close to the **HALLS PLACE** junction - **PCSO ROBERTSON** has been made aware and will conduct patrols , and any issues witnessed will be addressed. Vehicle that has been mentioned by reporting person has been witnessed , however it is not the only one . Will monitor the issue and if issue carries on **BOTH** vehicles will be issued with advisories.



Abuse of the 999 system is an offence and may lead to prosecution.

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Youths shouting abuse at a resident who has hit them with a bag whilst passing them— **RESPONSE OFFICERS** have attended and spoken to all parties the bag was an accident whilst walking past and it has blown out of control— youths have been advised not to hang around area , and local community policing team have been notified
- Elderly female has been sighted on DUNHAM ROAD , carrying bags and struggling to walk , reporting person stopped and asked if they needed help , in which the elderly person then shouted abused and started to shout at them—
- 2nd report of a female struggling to walk with a suspected broken ankle—reporting person asked if they needed help and received abuse—**Both reports may be linked, AMBULANCE** was called , **PCSO ROBERTSON** will contact both reporting persons for reassurance
- 2 suspicious males sighted , one wearing a BALACLAVA and entering an address— **RESPONSE** officers deployed , spoken to the owners of the address and they are getting work on on the house. **MALE** with BALACLAVA is a neighbour who was returning home from work
- Concern over an FEMALE who states that they are thinking of hurting themselves , due to being bullied , report has come from a friend of theirs—**RESPONSE OFFICERS** deployed and spoken to the FEMALE , there were no injuries and spoken about the issues. **PCSO ROBERTSON** has spoken to school in regards to this and school are aware of an issue and are dealing with.
- Concerns over neighbours possibly using drugs and causing issues with noise—**PCSO ROBERTSON** will make contact with the reporting person and conduct reassurance visit and gain an INTEL link if required
- Concern for a male who has not been seen for 4 days and curtains have been closed— **Advised to contact AMBULANCE** , however **PCSO ROBERTSON** will speak to Reporting person as the male is known to him.
- 12x mountain bikes and a washing line have appeared on reporting persons garden— **property is getting renovated, so there is rubbish on garden already. This is a case of fly tipping**
- Issues with neighbour possibly parking too close to reporting persons vehicle to make it difficult to get in—it is a public area , **NO private parking spots** , so will speak to both parties to gain a picture of the issue going on. **PCSO ROBERTSON** has spoken to victim and is going to speak to other party
- Reporting person is feeling harassed due to ex friend talking about her and possibly driving past , taking pictures and intimidating her—**PCSO ROBERTSON** conducted a reassurance visit and **RESPONSE** officers attended
- Male being rude and aggressive at the staff from the PREMIERE INN—**RESPONSE** related issue and **MALE ARRESTED**
- Daughter getting bullied at school , getting hit , being sent messages—**PCSO ROBERTSON** conducted reassurance visit and aware of issue, safeguarding advice given
- Intoxicated male is in reporting persons back garden, with a dog off its lead—**PCSO ROBERTSON** will attend for a reassurance visit and get in touch with **WEAVER VALE** as this may be an issues which they are aware off.

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN (cont)

- Group of youths knocking and banging on reporting persons door—PCSO ROBERTSON has tried to get in touch with reporting person to obtain the CCTV , to try and identify the youths.

THEFT

- Electric Push Bike has been taken from the back garden overnight—Crimed and is being investigated

BURGULARY


- Hinges of rear patio doors have been tampered with. Home is getting renovated so therefore there may be an attempt to get the tools —**RESPONSE OFFICERS** dispatched, there is **NO** obvious damage showing an attempt break in or that there was a successful gained entry. PCSO ROBERTSON will make contact for reassurance , no further issues.

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Possible sink hole has appeared outside reporting persons address - **HIGHWAYS** have been notified
- Vans parking on double yellow lines on LONDON ROAD
 - 2nd report in regards to VANS parking on LONDON ROAD—PCSO ROBERTSON has witnessed the obstruction and spoke to the owners of the vans. Understand that they are doing work however, can not just leave vehicles on double yellow lines. Vehicles have been moved

SHOPLIFTING

- Male was caught shoplifting by staff and he has left his bag —**crimed**. PCSO ROBERTSON will call and see if CCTV and property has been obtained.

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- third party report in regards to a friend that has been involved in a fight and is cut badly—**there is no location or no details in regards to the injured party. And no further reports**
- Report from AMBULANCE stating that a female has left them and is feeling suicidal and is heading towards RIVER WEAVER—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and female located**
- Report of a Male Youth trying to set fire to a wheelie bin—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched , search made no trace of any youths fitting the description—PCSO ROBERTSON will contact reporting person to find out more information as they may be known to him**
- Strong smell of cannabis in the area when reporting person arrived home—**this has been logged as INTEL. PCSO ROBERTSON has provided email to reporting person to build an INTEL link**
- Number of youths throwing snowballs at passers by and cars—**No description of youths given and no details left of reporting person so no follow up can occur**
- Resident being threatening and abusive towards staff—
 - further report in regards to female being aggressive and assaulting staff

PCSO ROBERTSON has attended the address and spoken to all parties. Suspect has been spoken to and advised any further issues will mean further action will be taken.

- Group of school aged males running across the pond , when its all frozen
 - Group of Males throwing the bin into the pond
 - further report in regards to males throwing bins into the pond

PC BOX , together with PCSO ROBERTSON were dispatched , one male was located and spoken to in front of guardians when taken home. Another male was spoken to by PCSO ROBERTSON when attending his home address , who admitted to conducting this. And another home visit will be conducted to another male by PCSO ROBERTSON. (further information on Facebook page)

- Third persons report in regards to a female who wants to harm herself after receiving a video , stating that she will—
- Further report in regards to the above , as the reporting party have asked not to be contacted again by the female , and is still doing so—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched . Female none engaging with the officers but has been checked out by paramedics. And issue with communication has been crimed and being looked into.**
- Threatening emails being received from a builder in regards to payment—**CIVIL dispute , PCSO ROBERTSON completed reassurance call and provided safeguarding . RESPONSE officers attended appointment to look into this**
- Reporting persons mother has been drinking and is on the road and needs help to get her up - **Unfortunately no officers available and was advised as health issue to contact AMBULANCE**
- Concerns in regards to a FEMALE driver, driving erratic with children in the car—**Car details have been passed over , unknown to the police therefore will submit as INTEL , ANON report so therefore PCSO ROBERTSON can not contact reporting person**

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN—continued

- third party report in regards to a friend that has been involved in a fight and is cut badly—**there is no location or no details in regards to the injured party. And no further reports**
- Concern over a third party registering a vehicle at the reporting persons address and they are now receiving parking fines— **Has been linked as INTEL , PCSO ROBERTSON will attend and speak to reporting person**
- People reported smoking cannabis around the CORONET POND area—**there are no LINES OF ENQUIRY about times , dates etc . PCSO ROBERTSON will place on patrol plan**
- Concern over female planning to hurt herself—**RESPONSE officers have spoken to FEMALE and is a bit intoxicated and is with partner. There is no concern and safeguarding is in place with her being with partner.**

- further call in regards to the female—as reporting person is not happy how officers have dealt with this —**Reporting person RESPONSE OFFICERS have done what they were required to do , ensure safe and well and with someone who can look after her, if there are concerns about someones health—advised to contact AMBULANCE**

SHOPLIFTING

- Theft of Meat and washing pods —**crimed and CCTV footage will be collected by PCSO ROBERTSON if Area Investigation Team have not already**



DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Neighbour has attended reporting persons address and is shouting abuse and kicking the car
- 2nd report of neighbour attended reporting persons address and shouted verbal abuse at her. **Both reports are linked. There was an earlier issue which resulted in one neighbour shouting abuse and kicking car and then later in day the affected neighbour went and approached the neighbour that kicked the car. CCTV footage was available of the 2nd issues. RESPONSE OFFICERS attended and spoke to all parties , community policing team made aware**
- Suspicious vehicle has been sighted driving up and down road , leaving area and then coming back 15mins later—**PCSO ROBERTSON has spoken to reporting person , there has been no further sightings of the male , since the report.**
- Suspicious male walking past location area number of times in a set amount of time , during a small space of time—**logged as INTEL , PCSO ROBERTSON will contact reporting person for reassurance visit.**
- Concern over a male who hasn't been seen—**Not a police issues , passed over to RIGHT CARE RIGHT PERSON**
- Female getting threats and is trying to intimidate her , so with that she is worried for her safety—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit and provide safeguarding.**

SHOPLIFTING

- Male has shoplifted from SPAR—**crimed and CCTV footage will be collected by PCSO ROBERTSON if Area Investigation Team have not already**

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Large pick up truck parked outside DAVENHAMS and is causing issues as road is narrow and has been there for a week—**PCSO ROBERTSON was in area for a community event on day it was reported and there was no pick up truck in area causing any obstructions**


HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Tree fallen and is blocking the road—**HIGHWAYS already dealing with this by time RESPONSE officers arrived**

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Reporting person possibly being followed by a male which has been mentioned previously on FACEBOOK—**PC BOX** has already spoken to a male in regards to this, and **PCSO ROBERTSON** is aware of this issue. Will speak to the reporting person for reassurance and gain more information that **PC BOX** may be able to use
- Nuisance messages being sent from fake accounts in relation to reporting persons partner—**PCSO ROBERTSON** will attend and speak to the reporting person to gain more information and provide safeguarding
- Dog that was not on its lead ran towards reporting person and attacked their dog—Callback has occurred by another officer—No injuries. **PCSO ROBERTSON** will speak to reporting person to gain exact time to check CCTV. Plus reporting person has got an image of the owner. Will obtain this and get an id check and if possible a home visit will be conducted.

NEW ISSUES - Speeding on LONDON ROAD into the village coming down the hill and drivers ignore the 20MPH flashing sign—**Community Speed watch is operational within the area , which works with PCSO ROBERTSON. Plus PCSO ROBERTSON will be doing speed monitoring on LONDON ROAD soon**

Parking on HARTFORD ROAD especially at the weekend— **HARTFORD ROAD is on the patrol plan—any issues witnessed by PCSO ROBERTSON will be looked into**

Footpaths being obstructed and blocked due to residents having short driveways and long vehicles—**PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this issue with the footpath on HARTFORD ROAD. If the owner of the vehicle makes every effort not to cause an obstruction then this will be considered. However if there is an UNECESSARY OBSTRUCTION then a FIXED PENALTY NOTICE will be issued**

More Weekend Patrols—**only PCSO ROBERTSON can guarantee this and weekend patrols due to speeding and parking will be done**






SPEEDING

You have requested speed gun sessions on certain roads via the residents voice.


And we have acted.



Only 2 Speed Gun sessions were conducted in January


LEFTWICH—London Road which is 30MPH , just before the 20MPH speed change.

Very busy road but only 2 offences captured



MOULTON—Main Road which is 20MPH , the speed gun session was completed on a Saturday morning , which would mean more people out and about as school is not in session.

There was a total of 8 offences captured with the highest speed being 29 MPH, and most of the offences were by drivers going out of the village.



More areas will be looked into as well as if there is an area with offences captured , the more speed gun sessions will take place there.



MINI POLICE

KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE PUT THROUGH THEIR PACE

When members of the public apply to become a police officer they have to complete the fitness test, which is completed by doing the BLEEP TEST. As part of the Mini Police program and as an ice breaker , the Mini Police take on the BLEEP TEST. To pass the fitness test, officers must pass level 5.6 or if they want to become Firearms officers , they must pass level 9.6. The Kingsmead Mini Police smashed the BLEEP TEST with nearly all of them pass level 5.6 and some Mini Police going all the way to level 15. They will give some of our officers a run for their money



WEAVER VALE SUPPORTS THE MINI POLICE PROGRAM



All have been spoken to with parents / guardians present and with support of them , both of the youths worked alongside PCSO ROBERTSON completing LITTER PICKS

Safeguarding advice given to all dog owners. If you are unsure how your dog is going to react when out for a walk , to safeguard them and others, it must be on a lead

Patrols are occurring around CORONET POND area due to RESIDENTS feedback over suspicious activity
