What have we been doing recently?

Due to the priorities you have submitted on Residents Voice Surveys in the last months your local officers have taken the following action:

- Red light patrols have been undertaken on the A6 Buxton Road;
- School parking patrols which lead to a fixed penalty notice issued to a heavy goods vehicle for obstruction of the pavement on Buxton Old Road;
- Increased foot patrols around the Newtown area at night;
- Local officers have deviated to night shifts to provide a greater presence at night following resident's concerns of burglary;

I am part of the Macclesfield neighbourhood policing team covering the Disley ward along with PC David Jackson. We cover the area shown on the map, including Newtown and parts of Lyme Park. In all, we are responsible for looking after over 4,000 residents and ensuring tasks such as problem solving, burglary prevention, school talks, road safety and visibility patrols are carried out.
